




Male Reproductive System

- <u>gen</u>ital = pertaining to reproductive, sexual organs


Male Reproductive System

- prosta<u>ti</u>tis
- prostate cancer, adenocarcinoma of the prostate


- sexually transmitted diseases (STDs)




- 3. Signs and symptoms

- dysmenor<u>rhe</u>a, menstrual cramp, painful periods
- abnormal vaginal bleeding
- leukor<u>rhe</u>a, va<mark>gi</mark>nal pru<u>ri</u>tus (itching)
- hype<u>rem</u>esis gravidarum






6. Medical and surgical procedures


- hysterectomy, salpingectomy, oophorectomy, total abdominal hysterectomy with bilateral salpingo-oophorectomy (TAH-BSO)
- amniocen<u>te</u>sis
- normal vaginal delivery (NVD), Cesarean section (C-section)
- bilateral tubal ligation, tubectomy
- di<u>la</u>tion (or dila<u>ta</u>tion) and curet<u>tage</u> (D&C)
- Assisted reproductive technology (ART) : In vitro fertilization (IVF), Gamete intrafallopian transfer (GIFT)



Intraunterine Device (IUD)








2. Structure and Function

- growth hormone (GH), somato<u>tro</u>pin
- a<u>dre</u>nocortico<u>trop</u>ic hormone (ACTH)
- thyroid hormone, thyroxine
- parathyroid hormone, parathormone (PTH)
- <u>in</u>sulin
- corticos<u>ter</u>oid
- gluco<u>cor</u>ticoid, <u>cor</u>tisol





Endocrine System

- 4. Lab investigation
- thyroid function test (TFT, blood hormone level)
- fasting blood sugar (FBS)
- postprandial, post cibum (p.c.)



Endocrine System 5. Diseases • hyperthyroidism, thyrotoxicosis • hypothyroidism

- multi<u>nod</u>ular goiter, goitre (*british*)
- thyroid fol<u>lic</u>ular ade<u>no</u>ma, thyroid cancer
- hypergly<u>ce</u>mia, diabetes mellitus (DM)
- diabetes insipidus (DI), antidiu<u>ret</u>ic hormone (ADH)
